The International Association for Statistics Education (IASE) was established in 1991 by the International Statistical Institute (ISI). It makes a significant contribution to promoting the development and improvement of statistics education on an international scale. Your organisation can contribute by taking out Institutional Membership. The cost is modest. It is, however, an important way of helping to promote statistics literacy.

As an institutional member, your organisation will have the opportunity to participate directly in IASE's activities and to benefit from the variety of concessions available to individual members. For example, your organisation may designate a representative to attend any of the IASE or ISI international meetings at the reduced registration fee offered to IASE members. This includes the regular IASE satellite meetings (associated with ISI Congresses and International Conferences on Mathematics Education, ICMEs), and International Conferences on Teaching Statistics, ICOTS's.

Institutional Members also receive the ISI *Newsletter* and occasional publications such as the *IASE Review*. Furthermore, they may subscribe at reduced rates to other statistics journals, for example *International Statistical Review*, *Teaching Statistics* (which includes *IASE Matters*), and may purchase IASE and ISI education publications at discounted prices, including the Proceedings from international conferences on teaching statistics.

Subscribe now, and your organisation will receive, **an additional free book** (see the back form).

An Institutional Member from a **developed country** has to pay an amount of € 210 per annum and an Institutional Member from a **less developed country** has to pay an amount of € 55 per annum.
