GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF PRESENTATIONS

The paper/poster presentations will be uploaded via a personalized link that will be sent to you shortly by email. The following guidelines are intended to help you prepare your presentation that will be viewed by the participants via a link to access that private section for the virtual conference.

- You should prepare a 5-minute presentation in the format of your choice: Video or PowerPoint.
- A 5-minute video presentation will include you presenting in front of a camera or your voice over the PowerPoint. Multiple screens can be used: One for the PowerPoint presentation and a smaller one including you as the presenter.

- The video should not be more than 5 minutes in length and the size limit is up to 300 MB.
- Alternatively, a plain PowerPoint presentation file (as a visual mode of communication) can be uploaded.
- All information such as the title of your paper/poster, authors' name, affiliation must appear on the first slide of your presentation.
- All presentation must be in English.
