Revista de Educación Estadística [REDES]

Ya está en circulación la Revista de Educación Estadística [REDES, por sus siglas en español]. Es la primera revista en español y portugués dedicada exclusivamente a la Educación Estadística. Es un proyecto liderado por el Dr. Danilo Díaz-Levicoy, desde la Facultad de Ciencias Básicas de la Universidad Católica del Maule, Chile.

Es una publicación semestral, con publicación en abril y octubre, cuyo objetivo es

aportar al conocimiento que se genera producto de la investigación científica en el campo de la Educación Estadística. Publica artículos de investigación originales e inéditos, escritos en español o portugués, que puedan ser referencia para el desarrollo de la Educación Estadística en el ámbito regional y mundial. Los artículos son seleccionados por el proceso de arbitraje externo, mediante el sistema doble ciego.

Además, puede publicar ensayos los cuales serán recibidos estrictamente a solicitud o encargo del Consejo Editor y también serán arbitrados. Está dirigida a educadores e investigadores interesados en la enseñanza o aprendizaje de la estadística y la probabilidad en todos los niveles y modalidades de la educación.

The Journal of Statistical Education [REDES, for its acronym in Spanish] is now in circulation. It is the first journal in Spanish and Portuguese dedicated exclusively to Statistics Education. It is a project led by Dr. Danilo Díaz-Levicoy, from the Faculty of Basic Sciences of the Universidad Católica del Maule, Chile.

It is a biannual publication, published in April and October, whose objective is to contribute to the knowledge generated by scientific research in the field of Statistics Education. It publishes original and unpublished research articles, written in Spanish or Portuguese, which can be a reference for the development of Statistics Education in the regional and global scope. The articles are selected by the external arbitration process, through the double-blind system.

In addition, it may publish essays which will be received strictly upon request or order of the Editorial Board and will also be refereed. It is addressed to educators and researchers interested in the teaching or learning of statistics and probability at all levels and modalities of education.
