The Assistant Editor—Manuscripts works with the SERJ Editors to manage the copyediting and production of up to three issues of SERJ per year, and is responsible for ensuring that published manuscripts and whole issues are of high quality in terms of their English language, style, and formatting. To best achieve this, the Assistant Editor should have strengths in language copyediting (in English) and APA formatting, and have the communication skills necessary to interact with authors to finalize manuscripts for publication in a collegial and efficient manner. In addition to these qualifications, some familiarity is preferred with research in the field of statistics education (broadly viewed, or related educational areas).
