

International Statistical Literacy Poster Competition 2014–2015 for students — from research to a story

The competition challenges you to select a topic on which you conduct a mini survey and report your survey process and statistical results on a poster.

The winning posters of the national competitions will participate in the international competition.

TEACHERS, REGISTER YOUR SCHOOL IN THE COMPETITION!

1. Working in teams of two to three persons, select a topic that interests you and conduct a mini survey.
2. Summarise the survey process and the results on a poster.
3. Select the best poster in your school and send it in electronic format to your local country coordinator.
4. The winning posters will participate in the international competition the winners of which will be displayed at the 60th World Statistics Congress of the ISI in Rio de Janeiro in Brazil in the summer 2015.

PARTICIPATION

The competition has two categories:

- students born in 1999 and younger
- students born in 1996 and younger

No participation fee.

The international competition will run until 14 March 2015.
